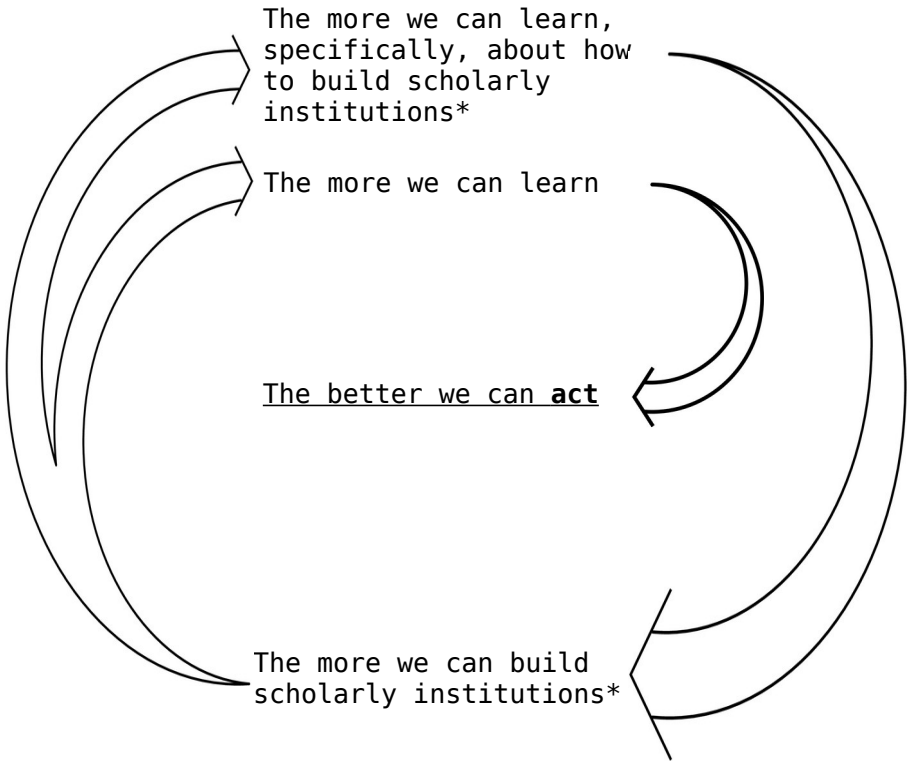


The Scholarly Loop



* A *scholarly institution* is an institution[†] expressly designed to facilitate scholarly practices[‡].

† The word *institution* is here used in the general, sociological sense, to mean any social regularity. Institutions can be virtual or in-person, formal or casual, centralized or decentralized, small or big.

‡ By *scholarly practices* are meant such things as reading, writing, deep thinking, deep conversation, art, math, and science. All these practices require long uninterrupted flow states, and transform the self.

Let Me Think is a student collective which utilizes the Scholarly Loop to create the material conditions necessary for scholarship. Our vision is a world where scholarly practice[†] is accessible, and our mission is to enact and envision the future of scholarly institutions*, informed by the past and present of scholarship.
